HayStack NO BAKE COOKIES

- 1- 11oz package of chocolate chips or butterscotch chips or peanut butter chips
- 1- 12 oz package chow mein noodles (dry)

Melt chocolate or other chips in double boiler until just melted, (Or in microwave at 30 second then check, do another 30 seconds at a time until melted)

Pour noodles in a bowl. Pour melted chips otop. Stir. Take a small spoonful and place on waxed paper. Do this with the entire batch. Let dry on wax paper for a couple hours. Enjoy!
